HAIR & BEAUTY

HD Brows

Pre-Treatment Advice

- 1. A patch test for tinting procedures is required 24-48 hours prior to your first appointment. This should also be done if it has been six months since your last tinting appointment or your medical circumstances have changed in between appointments.
- 2. A patch test for waxing can be booked if you are worried about skin sensitivity.
- 3. Please avoid applying self tan to the eyebrow area for three days prior to your HD Brow appointment if having a tint.

Aftercare Advice

- 1. Please inform your HD Brow therapist immediately if you experience a reaction.
- 2. Avoid the use of swimming pools, sun beds, sauna's and products containing perfume for at least 24 hours after the procedure.
- 3. Do not apply self-tanning products directly to the brow area as this may effect the colour of the tint.
- 4. Avoid microdermabrasion, granular exfoliator or skin thinning products for 72 hours.
- 5. Remember that your results with be darker, sharper and more defined for the first 24 hours after treatment.
- 6. Avoid harsh make up removal products to prolong tint retention.
- 7. Avoid tweezing areas your therapist has recommended you grow in between appointments.

HAIR & BEAUTY

Henna Brows

Pre-Treatment Advice

- 1. A patch test for tinting procedures is required 24-48 hours prior to your first appointment. This should also be done if it has been six months since your last tinting appointment or your medical circumstances have changed in between appointments.
- 2. A patch test for waxing can be booked if you are worried about skin sensitivity.
- 3. Please avoid applying self tan to the eyebrow area for three days prior to your Henna Brow appointment.

Aftercare Advice

- 1. Avoid swimming, sun beds, saunas and steam rooms for at least 24 hours. Avoid sunbathing for 24 hours, as this can cause the tint to fade.
- 2. Do not rub the area treated
- 3. Avoid heat treatments for 24 hours
- 4 Do not apply brow make-up for at least 24 hours after your treatment
- 5. Please note that oil based make up remover can cause the tint to fade quicker
- 6. Exposure to the sun/UV lights for long periods can cause the tint to fade quicker.
- 7. Do not apply any perfumes or fake tan to the area from where hair has been removed for at least 24 hours.

Lash & Brow Tint/Tidy

Pre-Treatment Advice

A patch test is required at least 24-48 hours prior to a tinting procedure if:

- 1. This is your first tinting appointment at the salon.
- 2. You have not had a tint procedure in at least six months
- 3. Your medical circumstances have changed since your last appointment.
- 4. If you have any concerns discuss this with a member of staff prior to booking.
- 5. A patch test for waxing can also be booked if your are concerned about skin sensitivity.

Aftercare Advice

Eyebrow Waxing/Tweezing

- 1. Do not have a hot bath/shower or use a sauna, steam room or swimming pool 24 hours after treatment.
- 2. Do not use a sunbed or solarium for 24 hours after treatment.
- 3. Do not apply any perfume or self-tan to the waxed area for at least 72 hours.

Eyelash/Eyebrow Tinting

- 1. If any redness or irritation occurs, use a damp cotton wool compress. If this doesn't help, seek medical advice.
- 2. Strong UV light can fade a tint quicker.
- 3. Avoid eye make-up for 12 hours.
- 4. Avoid touching/rubbing the eyes after a tint application.

Brow Lamination

Aftercare Advice

- 1. For the first 24 hours after your treatment it's important not to allow water to come in to contact with your lashes
- 2. For 2 days afterwards do not steam your face, use a steam bath, swim or wash your face with hot water
- 3. Be gentle whilst cleansing your brows, avoid using micellar water over this area as many have a high ph which may dry the skin.
- 4. No water, steam or any oil or water based creams or lotions for 24 hours post treatment. It takes 24 hours for the hairs to stay laminated to there new shape. Liquid on the brows can wash out the treatment resulting in hairs taking back their previous form.
- 5. Brow conditioning is a must to insure vitality and nourish ment to the brow hairs. Hairs can become dry and brittle without it. Brow conditioning can aid in helping brow hair regrowth.
- 6. Brush your brows twice a day.
- 7. Pop in for a maintenance tint, shape and moisturising treatment 2- 4 weeks post treatment.

Additional Advice

If you're in any doubt, please ask your Brow Lamination technician for expert advice on how best to look after your brows. Brow Lamination is a low maintenance treatment meaning you don't need to return to the salon after your treatment.

However we do recommend using our Brow lamination Conditioning Serum at home to help nourish and strengthen brows and keep them looking healthy. Ultimately, this means you can enjoy the effects of your brow lamination treatment for longer.

LVL Lash Lift

Aftercare Advice

- 1. For the first 24 hours after your treatment it's important not to allow water to come in to contact with your lashes.
- 2. For 2 days afterwards do not steam your face, have a steam bath, swim or wash your face with hot water.
- 3. Use oil free make-up remover if mascara is worn.
- 4. Don't rub your eyes when washing your face always pat the lashes dry after cleansing.
- 5. Ensure lashes are not manipulated into different positions (e.g. when sleeping, cleansing the face, applying moisturiser or cosmetics).

Additional Advice

If you're in any doubt, please ask your Nouveau Lashes technician for expert advice on how best to look after your LVL lashes. Our LVL Lash Lift is a low maintenance treatment meaning you don't need to return to the salon after your treatment.

However we do recommend using our Nouveau Lashes Lash & Brow Conditioning Serum at home to help nourish and strengthen lashes and keep them looking healthy. Ultimately, this means you can enjoy the effects of your LVL treatment for longer. To keep your lashes looking dark, return to the salon after 4 weeks to top up your tint.

HAIR & BEAUTY

Eyelash Extensions

Pre-Treatment Advice

Please attend your appointment free from eye make up. If your eyelashes are fair and you require an eyelash tint, please book this appointment separately. Eyelash tint treatments require a patch test if you have never had one within our salon or it is has been six months since your last tint. Individual lashes are black in colour so a tint is suggested if your lashes are light. Contact lenses must be removed prior to treatment.

A patch test is required 24-48 hours prior to an eyelash extension appointment. Please book in for a patch test if you have never had eyelash extensions applied within the salon previously.

Aftercare Advice

- 1. Do not allow water to come in to contact with lashes for the first two hours following your treatment.
- 2. Do not steam your face, use a steam room/sauna, swim or wash your face with hot water for two days following your lash treatment.
- 3. Do not use waterproof mascara or oil based make up removers on your lashes as this will weaken the bond.
- 4. Do not curl your lash extensions.
- 5. Do not rub your eyes when washing your face. Always pat your eyes gently after cleansing.
- 6. Please book in to have your eyelashes removed professionally or you can purchase the approved remover from Sutherlands Hair and Beauty. Follow the removal instructions given to you by your therapist.
